



Loretta P. Lacey Academic Leadership Award

Call for Nominations

The Association of Teachers of Maternal and Child Health (ATMCH) created the Loretta P. Lacey Award to recognize leadership in MCH education, research, policy development and/or advocacy. ATMCH sponsors the award in memory of Loretta P. Lacey, a former faculty member at the University of Illinois at Chicago and a leader in MCH education.

Eligibility Requirements:

The nominee must:

- Be a faculty member in a health or health-related institution who is actively involved in MCH teaching and/or research;
- Be an ATMCH member;
- Be at mid-career (i.e., not yet a full professor), but must have already begun to establish a positive reputation in MCH; and
- Have demonstrated leadership skills and show potential for future career development.

Deadline:

All nominations must be received by **August 19, 2011**. ATMCH will announce the awardee on our website in September 2011 and the awardee will receive a plaque at the Fall ATMCH meeting, to be held Sunday, October 30, 2011 at the APHA annual meeting in Washington, DC. There will also be a luncheon/dinner in the awardee's honor during APHA.

Application:

The submission must include a letter of nomination and the nominee's curriculum vitae, and document the nominee's accomplishments and her/his future potential. Send the letter and CV to the ATMCH secretariat care of:
